

## What stands in the way? Issues → Solutions

Cloud-Native Receiving tracks lot codes on receipts from DSD, Commissaries & ASNs are not entirely reliable for traceability Other stores Disconnected upstream and downstream End-to-end visibility for source-to-store data providers traceability Time consuming scans for every single lot Prompt-driven workflows for receivers to code from DC to store scan ONLY high-risk barcodes Generate transformed lot codes for all Difficult to track ingredient lot codes for fresh fresh prepared items with high-risk prepared ingredients Leverage the largest supplier network in Missing data fields from suppliers grocery retail Bi-directional data sync between upstream Gaps in upstream data from DC to store and downstream data providers to fill workflows missing gaps






